

Troop 149

A Brief History

The history of Troop 149 is a little sketchy, but there is some information from the archives that have been handed down from person to person. We will attempt to combine as much information as we can and post it here so future Scouts and parents can learn about the history of the troop. Troop 149's history began on June 6, 1991. The original charter was with Falcon Middle School in Falcon Colorado. Six Scouts and Two adult leaders made up the Troop that day. David Read started as the first Scoutmaster and Brian Horner became the first Eagle Scout. Since then the troop has grown to a membership of over 50 Scouts and 10 adult leaders. In February 2005 the Troop rechartered with Grace Community Church in Falcon.

In the last 17 years, 250 Scouts have been lucky enough to call Troop 149 'their Troop'. Troop 149 still continues to grow, though Scouts will come and Scouts will go, each Scout that calls Troop 149 theirs, if even just for a short while, will always take away the values of Scouting and the Troop and once instilled those values can and often do, last a lifetime.

Though many found the trail to Eagle a lofty goal to attain the Troop has had 18 of its Scouts reach that level with more on the way. Achieving the rank of Eagle is a tremendous achievement and deserves to be recognized:
