

Medical Information Forms

All participants (youth and adults) attending Camp Dobbins must complete a state of Colorado Scout Camp medical form supplied by the Denver Area Council, BSA.

All campers and leaders staying at camp 72 hours or more must complete the Class 3 section of the state of Colorado Scout Camp Medical Form. Adult leaders staying at camp less than 72 hours must provide at least Class 1 medical form; a Class 1 medical form is a brief health history that doesn't require a physician's signature.

Youth participants will individually turn in their completed Class 3 State of Colorado Medical Form when they go through the check-in process. To ensure that forms are available, most troops collect the forms before camp; however, you must then distribute them back to the Scouts for the medical check-in. Adult leaders must also turn in their medical form during check-in or upon arrival at camp if not with the unit. Shortly after check-in, the medical director will give the unit leader a written list of participants with incomplete or missing medical forms. The unit leader will be asked to take the necessary steps to correct deficiencies within 24 hours.

Youth participants without a COMPLETED and properly signed State of Colorado Class 3 Medical Form as of 5:00 P.M. Monday must be picked up Monday night by the parents, or taken home by unit leaders. There is no fee refund.

Medical examinations for youth (and adults under age 40) are good for two years from the date of the doctor's examination. It is the responsibility of the Scout or troop to make copies of the medical form for future use. All medical forms become the property of the Denver Area Council and will NOT be returned to you at the end of the week. Medical forms used last year are archived and not available for use in the following season. All participants must provide a completed medical form for every year they attend camp.

All adult leaders 40 years of age or older are required to get a medical exam and complete a new State of Colorado Class 3 Medical Form EVERY YEAR. Adults 40 years old or older cannot reuse a previous year's medical examination.
